TOURNAMENT RULES 2016: 6 -a-side

1. Except where described below, normal FA laws & rules for football and mini-soccer will apply to all aspects of the tournament. There will be no offside. All free kicks will be direct.
2. All players must be aged 6 or over on 31 August 2015- i.e. born on or before 31 August 2015.
3. Each team will consist of 6 players plus up to 2 substitutes. Rolling substitutes are allowed. A player may only play for one team in the same age group.
4. The manager of the first named team in the schedule provides the match ball, chooses the end and kicks off. In case of shirt colour clashes, the first named team wears bibs or changes shirts.
5. If, in the opinion of the referee, there is an unfair advantage playing at one end of the pitch (for example, a strong wind), then the referee may decide to play two halves without a rest.
6. All matches will consist of one 8 minute period for league matches and one ten minute period for knockout stages, unless otherwise stated.
7. In the Under 7 and Under 8 competitions, there are no league rankings or knockout stages. Each team will play 5 matches.
8. The retreat rule for goal kicks will apply in the Under 7 and Under 8 age groups.
9. *THE FOLLOWING RULE **APPLIES ONLY** U9s and upwards: Goal kicks are to be taken from the goal line, and the goalkeeper is not permitted to kick from hands. The football must be thrown out.
10. In the league stages, 3 points will be awarded for a win, 2 points for a score draw and 1 point for a goalless draw. In the event of a tie, the league ranking will be decided by the team that won the game between the two tied teams. If this still fails to split the teams, then the deciding factors will be first goal difference and if still tied goals scored. If the teams are still tied, the league position will be decided with a penalty shoot out.
11. There will no extra time in the knock out stages. If the teams are level then there will be a penalty shoot out.

12. Penalty shoot outs will consist of three penalty kicks on each side. If the teams are still tied, then penalty kicks will continue until one team misses.

13. Any appeals must be accompanied with a £5 deposit (which will be refunded if upheld). Disputed will be resolved by the management and referee.

14. The organisers reserve the right to vary the tournament in any way they deem necessary.
